Professor Leanne Cutcher visit

Professor Leanne Cutcher (Professor of Management and Organisation Studies) visited on 14-15 October from the University of Sydney. During her time at UQ she gave a brown bag seminar on one of her working papers and ran a hugely insightful workshop (with over 50 registrations) on researching sensitive contexts, and being reflexive whilst in the field and afterwards. Leanne also kindly offered HDRs and staff the opportunity to book in with her for a one-to-one consultation for feedback on their own work.

Leanne's work explores discourse and practice and how they impact equality and inclusion in organisations and the communities they serve. Her research has explored issues of gender, age and Indigeneity in organisations, with a particular interest in alternative forms of organisation, including co-operatives, social enterprises, and community-owned organisations. Her current research funded by an ARC Discovery grant explores the role of culture in shaping strategy and practice in Aboriginal community-controlled organisations. Leanne's research engagement has led Leanne on her own journey of discovery about her Awabakal ancestry of which she is very proud.
