You may also receive credit towards the Bachelor of Advanced Finance and Economics (Honours) from shared courses or general electives with your first program of choice.

If you don't meet the prerequisite mathematical skills required to study this program, you can complete a bridging course via UQ College prior to the main QTAC offer round in mid-January. This can be studied in person over 4 weeks or online at your own pace over 12 months.
