## **Internet Appendix B: Log of Early Applications of Template**

Table B.1 provides a log of known (and sighted) completed pitch templates, in terms of: the pitch title, pitcher's identity, date that the pitch was completed and background circumstances for completing the pitch template. To give background to the last item, I have personally used the pitch template at doctoral/"young scholar" training events. These events are as follows – IAAER PDW 2013: International Association for Accounting Education and Research and Association of Chartered Certified Accountants Paper Development Workshop, Bucharest University of Economic Studies, Romania, June 2013; IAFDS7: 7th International Accounting and Finance Doctoral Symposium, Trondheim, Norway, June 2014; AFAANZ DS2014: Accounting and Finance Association of Australia and New Zealand Doctoral Symposium, Auckland New Zealand, July 2014; SIRCA YRW4: 4th SIRCA Young Researcher Workshop, Sydney, July 2014. Noteworthy in the table, is the fact that researchers from twelve different countries have used the template during this very early phase of its public exposure.
