

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN COMMERCE

The **Graduate Certificate in Commerce** provides students with an alternative pathway to the 2 year **Master of Commerce (32 units)** program.

Graduate Certificate in Commerce (GCCoM)*

Duration

0.5 years full-time; or part-time equivalent.
Can be commenced in Semester 1 or Semester 2.

Entry requirements

To enrol, a student must:

1. hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent with a GPA of at least 4 on a 7-point scale; OR
2. have completed post-secondary study and at least five years full-time work experience as approved by the Executive Dean; OR
3. have completed at least seven years full-time work experience as approved by the Executive Dean.

Program requirements

Students are required to obtain 8 units from the MCom(32 units) course list comprising:

- 6 units from Part A; and
- 2 units from Part A or Part B.

Graduate Certificate in Commerce study plan (0.5 year program) For students articulating into the Master of Commerce (32 units)

Students with an articulation offer into the Master of Commerce (32 units) program should also refer to the study plan for their specific field within the MCom(32 units).
