

MASTER OF INTERNATIONAL COMMERCIAL LAW/MASTER OF COMMERCE

This unique 2-year dual program offers students a rare opportunity to attain two sought-after qualifications through the combined **Master of International Commercial Law and Master of Commerce (24 units)**. By studying these programs as a dual, students will acquire two degrees in a shorter timeframe than if studying them individually.

Aimed at those working in a wide variety of commercial enterprises, banking and financial institutions, as well as lawyers, this exciting new program will develop your understanding of the Australian legal system, enhance analytical reasoning, and develop specialist knowledge in one of the following fields: Applied Finance, Information Systems, or Professional Accounting.

Master of International Commercial Law/Master of Commerce (MICLaw/MCom(24 units))**

Duration

2 years full-time; or part-time equivalent.

Entry requirements

To enrol, a student must meet the entry requirements for both the MICLaw and MCom(24 units) programs.

Program requirements

A student is required to obtain 32 units comprising:

- 16 units from Part A of the MICLaw course list; and
- 12 units from Part A of the MCom(24 units) course list in an approved field; and
- 4 units from Part A or Part B of the MCom(24 units) course list.

*** Students must undertake a field of study in the MCom(24 units). For students who have previously undertaken studies in business or commerce, entry will only be considered for a field of study not already undertaken (some exceptions may apply to Professional Accounting).*
