

MASTER OF COMMERCE (24 UNITS)

The 1.5 year **Master of Commerce** is designed for students with a bachelor's degree in business (or a similar field) to develop knowledge in a new field.

Students completing the Master of Commerce must complete a field of study, concentrating on one of three areas of professional development: Applied Finance, Information Systems, or Professional Accounting. Students have an opportunity to specialise in up to two fields of study or complete research electives.

Graduates of the Master of Commerce (24 units) may be eligible for membership with the Australian Computer Society, CPA Australia, or Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand, depending on their chosen field of study.

Master of Commerce (MCom(24 units))**

Duration

1.5 years full-time; or part-time equivalent.
Can be commenced in Semester 1 or Semester 2.

Entry requirements

To enrol, a student must hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent in the same discipline with a GPA of at least 4.5 on a 7-point scale.

Program requirements

Students are required to obtain 24 units from the MCom(24 units) course list comprising:

- 12 units from one field of study in Part A; and
- the remaining 12 units as an approved second field of study from Part A, or from a combination of courses from Part A, Part B, Part C and/or other courses approved by the Head of School (up to a maximum of 4 units). Part C courses require permission from the Head of School prior to enrolment.

*** Students must undertake a field of study in the MCom(24 units). This program does not assume prior knowledge or training in the available fields of study. If you've studied in a related discipline, consider if each field of study will extend your expertise and support your career plans (some exceptions may apply to Professional Accounting).*
