

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN TOURISM, HOTEL AND EVENT MANAGEMENT

The **Graduate Certificate in Tourism, Hotel and Event Management** provides students with an alternative pathway to the 2 year **Master of Tourism, Hotel and Event Management (32 units)** program.

Graduate Certificate in Tourism, Hotel and Event Management (GCTHEM)

Duration

0.5 years full-time; or part-time equivalent.
Can be commenced in Semester 1 or Semester 2.

Entry requirements

To enrol, a student must:

1. hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent with a GPA of at least 4 on a 7-point scale; OR
2. have completed post-secondary study and at least five years full-time work experience as approved by the Executive Dean; OR
3. have completed at least seven years full-time work experience as approved by the Executive Dean.

Program requirements

Students are required to obtain 8 units from the MTHEM(32 units) course list comprising:

- 8 units from Part A.

Graduate Certificate in Tourism, Hotel and Event Management study plan (0.5 year program)

Students with an articulation offer into the Master of Tourism, Hotel and Event Management (32 units) should also refer to the study plan for their specific field within the MTHEM(32 units).
