

MASTER OF TOURISM, HOTEL AND EVENT MANAGEMENT (24 UNITS)

The 1.5-year **Master of Tourism, Hotel and Event Management** is designed for students with a bachelor's degree in one of these fields with a high-level qualification to enhance their career progression.

Students have the opportunity to concentrate their studies in one of three areas of professional development: Event Management, Hotel Management, or Travel and Tourism Management. In addition, students can elect to specialise in up to two fields of study or complete research electives.

Master of Tourism, Hotel and Event Management (MTHEM(24 units))

Duration

1.5 years full-time; or part-time equivalent.
Can be commenced in Semester 1 or Semester 2.

Entry requirements

To enrol, a student must hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent in the same discipline with a GPA of at least 4.5 on a 7-point scale.

Program requirements

Students are required to obtain 24 units from the MTHEM(24 units) course list comprising:

- 6 units from Part A; and
- 2 units from Part B; and
- 16 units from Part C or Part D, which may comprise one or two fields of study, and/or other courses approved by the Head of School (up to a maximum of 4 units). Part D courses require permission from the Head of School prior to enrolment.
